At the outset of the meeting of District Level Vigilance and Monitoring Committee, Imphal East District, Shri Dr. Thokchom Meinya , Hon'ble M.P. (Lok Sabha) welcomed the members present and Shri R.K. Dinesh Singh, I.A.S, Deputy Commissioner, Imphal East District with the permission of the Chair deliberated on the business session of the meeting.

**Observations of the Meeting:**

**MGNREGS**

- i. It is observed in the meeting that there is an unemployment allowance case in Imphal East-II C.D. Block and this is to be resolved as early as possible.
- ii. To ensure proper safe keeping of the non-perishable material, a proper stock register is to be maintained at each G.P. so that these material components can be used later. Also purchase of materials should be made through purchase committees at the G.P.s

*Action:- All implementing Agencies. GPs, ZPs and LDs.*

- iii. It is also observed that no employment is provided to the SCs in Imphal East District inspite of about 300 SC families in Khundrakpam, Matai, Lamalai and Takhel Gram Panchayats. Block Development Officer-I and II have clarified that that no jobs is being demanded by these families. The Committee advised them to pay special attention to these Scheduled Caste families .

*Action:- Block Development Officer-I and II.*

- iv. It is also observed that there is a difference between the number of Job Card Holders and the number of works provided employment which should be checked by the implementing Agencies ( All GPs/ZPs & LDs).
- v. The Committee also stressed on need to dispose off RTI a applications quickly.

**SGSY:**

- i. It is observed that skilled artisans can be encouraged in the Self Help Groups. For this purpose skilled development training programmes is to be provided/organised.
- ii. Hon'ble M.L.A. Shri Ng. Bijoy Singh observed that maximum SHGs are in the Lamalai and Thongju area. He observed that such types of SHGs could be made operational for the district other parts of the district by creating awareness of this programme.
- iii. It is also observed that officials should go to the field more to generate awareness .

- iv. It is observed that number of banks catering to SGSY are very limited in Imphal East District. It is recommended that the Project Officer (SGSY) should tie up with the banks for increasing the numbers of banks for this purpose.
- v. The Committee also resolved to invite the lead bank manager (UBI) to the next meeting as special invitees.

*Action:- PO (SGSY) DRDA/IE.*

**IAY:**

- i. It is observed in the meeting that the progress of Block Development Officer, Imphal East - I is satisfactory and progress of Block Development Officer, Imphal East -II needs to be improved.
- ii. The final reports of the works taken up under IAY under Imphal East-II C.D. Block should be submitted on or before 18<sup>th</sup> Nov. 2011.

*Action:- Block Development Officer-II.*

**IWMP:**

- i. It is observed in the meeting that fund for implementation under 1<sup>st</sup> phase has been sanctioned. This is to be implemented in 11 (eleven) villages under Kshetrigaon (7 villages) and Lamlai (4 villages) area. This fund (13 lakh) is for generating awareness programme initially.

**DRDA Administration:**

- i. The committee observed that the vital positions of Project Officer (2 nos.) and Technical Assistant (1 no.) are vacant and needs to be filled up as early possible and Executive Director is directed to submit proposal for filling up the vacant post to the Government.
- ii. The committee observed that disparity in pay among Govt. Employees and DRDA employees needs to be looked into. For this matter the Executive Director, DRDA should make a proposal to the Government.
- iii. The committee further entrusted the Executive Director, DRDA to ensure computer training to the staff if necessary.

*Action:-ED/DRDA.*

**PMGSY:**

- i. Hon'ble MLA, Shri Ng. Bijoy Singh pointed out that Tinsid Road to National High Way 150 (distance 2 km) in his constituency which can be taken up under PMGSY as it fulfils the criteria of the scheme.
- ii. It is observed that the Chief Engineer, MSRRDA should be invited as special invitee to the next meeting. It was noted that the Chief Engineer, PMGSY needs to elaborate on the details of the scheme implementation.

**PHED/NRDWP:**

- i. It is observed in the meeting that there should be a technical person who can communicate with the Govt. about the difficulties and deficiencies in implementing the programme.
- ii. Committee also observed that awareness programme about the success stories where water tax is collected from the consumers and where water supply programmes are operating successfully, as a model. This is to be highlighted. The Committee Hon'ble Adhyaksha ZP and CEO(ZP) to present success stories before the Committee in its next meeting.

*Action:- CEO/ZP.*

**TSC:**

- i. The Assistant Engineer, PHED stated that the fund for the whole of Manipur was not released by the Govt. Of India and the utilisation certificate submitted by the Deptt. was also not accepted by the Govt. Of India. In this regard the committee directed concerned EE to submit a detail note so that the matter may be looked in to by the committee.

*Action:- EE/PHED.*

- ii. The committee also observed that the implementation of TSC is to be done by the DRDA as per development seminar for Imphal East. The proposal was also accepted in the seminar. The details of further progress in this regard is awaited.

**NSAP:**

- i. It is observed that the report of various NSAP schemes was satisfactory.  
*The meeting after a detailed discussion unanimously resolved the following:*
- i. All RTI cases should be disposed off as early as possible. The official must be sincere in disposing the RTI application.
- ii. The concerned Programme Officer should give strong instructions to the material purchase committee to maintained proper stock register for the purchase of the non perishable material component so that these material components can be used later on. ( Under MGNREGS).
- iii. Skilled development training programmes must be provided under SGSY.
- iv. As the number of banks catering to SGSY are very limited in Imphal East District. The Project Officer SGSY should tie up with bank for increasing the number of banks for this purpose.
- v. The Committee also resolved to invite the lead Bank Manager (UBI) to the next meeting as a Special Invitee.
- vi. The final report of the works taken up under IAY under Imphal East-II C.D. Block should be submitted on or before 18<sup>th</sup> of Nov.2011.
- vii. The awareness programme for the implementation of IWMP should be started as early as possible.
- viii. To request the concerned authority for filling up the vacant vital position of Project Officer - 2 nos. and Technical Assistant-1 no. of DRDA, Imphal East.
- ix. The Executive Director, DRDA Imphal East should make a proposal for the disparity in the pay among the Govt. Employees and DRDA Employees with the recommendation of the District Level Vigilance and Monitoring Committee, Imphal East.
- x. The Chief Engineer, MSRRDA should be invited as special invitee to the next meeting. It is noted that he should elaborate on the details of the schemes under PHED.
- xi. The Department should submit a write up note on the success stories of some area as a model of the scheme (NREDWP) in the next meeting. This story is to be highlighted.
- xii. The PHED should submit a detail note on the difficulties in implementing the scheme (TSC) so that the matter may be looked into by the committee for improvement and necessary action.
